

Why do Airedales need "Rescue"?

We are asked this question all the time. We've listed a few of the many reasons so you can understand the situations some of these dogs have come from.

- Lost or stray
- The owner dies
- The family moves and cannot take the Airedale with them
- The owner's job requires them to be away from home for long periods
- Divorce
- The family has a new baby and cannot handle both the Airedale and the child
- The owner is tired of the Airedale
- The owner has grown too old to care for the Airedale
- Owner or family illness or allergies
- The family cannot afford to keep the Airedale
- ... and many, many more reasons!

How we hear of Airedales in need

Our rescue Airedales come from a variety of sources. We learn about them from:

- Shelters and Humane Societies
- Volunteers
- Groomers
- Family members
- Petfinders
- Other interested parties
- Breeders
- Veterinarians
- Owners



How ATRA works

As soon as we are informed of an Airedale in need, our work begins.

- We hear of an Airedale in need.
- Arrangements are made to take possession of the Airedale and transport it to a veterinarian.
- If it appears to be a lost dog, attempts are made to reunite it with its family.
- If the Airedale is homeless, it is vaccinated and checked for heartworm and worms. The Airedale is spayed or neutered (if not done already) and treated for any medical condition.
- The Airedale is bathed and groomed if required.
- A foster home is located and the Airedale is placed temporarily for evaluation of temperament, personality and training.
- The search begins for the "right" home, matching the dog with the most appropriate family.
- The prospective new family arranges to meet the Airedale.
- An adoption contract is completed and a donation is requested. Typically \$300 to \$400 is donated.
- We follow up on our friends to see how things are going. We want both the new family and the Airedale to be happy.

- Contact a rescue volunteer.

- Fill out an application on-line through the website. If you do not have access to the internet, you can contact one of the names on the reverse side for an adoption packet.
- A volunteer will contact you. We will do a telephone interview and check your references.
- An ATRA volunteer will come to your home for a home visit. We like to personally visit with the people and see the home where one of our rescue Airedales will be living.
- Watch our website and newsletter for the "right" Airedale to come into rescue.
- Arrange to meet one of our volunteers and the Airedale.
- Welcome your new family member.
- Live happily ever after...


